## **Summary of Tuesday, September 24, 2013 Meeting**

### **“I’ve Got Something on My Mind” and Program Planning for 2014**

Working in small groups, attendees at the September meeting of the Pasadena Citizens' Advisory Council (PCAC) identified industry-related issues that are on their minds or those of their family, friends, coworkers, etc. They then brainstormed topics for future meetings to address these and other issues.

Eighteen topics were suggested, and then attendees were given sticky dots to “spend” on the topics they most want PCAC to schedule in 2014. Topping the list of priorities were pipelines, job opportunities in PCAC plants, and school programs that develop the future workforce needed by Pasadena industry. Other topics of high interest were health effects statistics, impacts of industry expansion on community, and cyber security.

A Program Planning Committee will take the input from the September meeting and draft a Program Plan for 2014, giving priority to the topics with the most sticky dots from community attendees. Once adopted by the membership, the plan will guide the development of agendas for the coming year.
