### **LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS:**

**Meet at OxyChem Deer Park PVC Plant, 1000 Tidal Road, Deer Park**

- From SH 225, take Tidal Road exit. Proceed down Tidal over two sets of railroad tracks, then go straight onto Oxy property. Two large OxyChem signs at entrance. Follow that road toward plant. There will be several parking lots before the gate and security guardhouse. Park in Visitor Parking. Go to security guardhouse with your ID to check in. OxyChem staff will be outside waiting to guide us to right buildings.
- **April 23 meeting will be held at the OxyChem Deer Park PVC plant, not at the church.**

### **DESCRIPTION OF TOPIC:**

- In a significant industrial event, such as a fire, explosion, or release requiring a shelter in place, both the plant and the city play vital roles. Last April, PCAC visited the City of Pasadena Emergency Operations Center (EOC). This April, we will visit OxyChem's EOC for its 5 Houston-area plants.
- The EOC is the room where subject matter experts come together to support field operations. When an incident increases in magnitude so much that the local plant needs assistance, OxyChem can activate its Central EOC, which will provide support to help control and mitigate the incident.
- Using a simple scenario, OxyChem will describe how they would respond to a significant event and how they would notify the city and other responsible city and county agencies and provide information for the community via CAER Online and other means.
- Emergency vehicles will be on display to show the kind of equipment the plant has available in the event of a significant incident.
